## Karen National Union (KNU) 17th Congress Statement

May 5, 2023

- 1. The KNU 17<sup>th</sup> Congress was held successfully from April 24 to May 4, 2023 in the respective congress assembly halls, at the Supreme Headquarters and in the districts, by use of the internet online system.
- 2. Initially, the KNU 17<sup>th</sup> Congress was scheduled to be held in June 2021. However, due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the resulting challenges due to coup d'état by the military, the Congress could not have been held in the scheduled period, and finally it was held in three stages. In the third stage of the Congress, a total of 160 representatives attended and it was successfully concluded.
- 3. The Congress was able to review and adopt the work and the political reports of the Central Standing Committee (CSC), and work reports of the various districts, departments and committees, covering the term of the 16<sup>th</sup> Congress, and amendments to the Constitution of the KNU and its bylaws, the basic principles and programs of the Karen national revolution, the future work programs of the KNU, prepared and submitted by the CSC.
- 4. The KNU 17<sup>th</sup> Congress has elected 45 Central Standing Committee (CSC) members, 11 Central Executive Committee (CEC) members and the Chief Justice.
